The scholarship is for one academic year and students may re-apply each year that they remain in good standing at their respective colleges.

The Bayside Presbyterian Church Scholarship Awards are administered through the Endowment Committee, which designates an amount each year to be divided among the recipients to fund the scholarship awards. This money has been generously donated by church members, and also through memorial gifts to the church.

Applications will become available mid-April and may be picked up at the church office or downloaded from the church website. Completed applications with essays and a photo may be turned into the office or emailed to Linda Vogl (lvogl@baysidepresby.org) by May 20th.
