Men of the Church History

From the October 9, 1951 Minutes: "It was voted to change the name from 'Men's Club' to 'Men's Christian Fellowship'".

At the March 2, 1954 meeting, the motion was carried that the Men's Fellowship would sponsor a Boy Scout Troop. Officers were elected, and money appropriated for this. Scout Troop 364, Bayside, Virginia, received its Charter on March 31, 1954. On February 11, 1954, during National Scout Week, a Court of Honor was held at the Church. This was preceded by a covered-dish supper attended by a capacity gathering of the parents and friends of the Scouts.

The interior and exterior of the Church and Sunday School buildings were kept painted and in good repair by the Men. Two outside chimneys, which were no longer needed, were disposed of. In the corridor between the two buildings lockers were built for the storage of Scout equipment, and other items.

On September 6, 1955, a Fishermen's Club was organized. The men meet at the Church every Monday evening and go forth two-by-two, to call on our members, and on those who are in need of a Church home.

John M. Crow, and Robert C. Darling were delegates to the Men's Conference at Massanetta, and have imparted the inspiration they received there to those who were not able to attend.

The Men's Christian Fellowship of Bayside Presbyterian Church received its Charter on March 29, 1955.
