During the year 1956 we had four circles, which was an increase of one over the preceding year. Our average attendance at the General Meeting was 30. For 1957 the average attendance was 28, with the same number of circles.

Our Prayer Group has continued to meet every Tuesday at 10:00 A.M., except during the summer of 1957. Cancer dressings are made one Tuesday out of each month during the winter.

The Women of the Church have continued to sponsor the Family Night Supper which is held whenever a fifth Tuesday in any month occurs. They are very well attended, and help us to become better acquainted with new members. A well planned program or film strip follows each supper.

The Blessing Box money has been spent as follows: One-half for ourselves, and one-half for others.

As projects, we furnished venetian blinds for the sanctuary, had the nursery tiled, sent old Sunday School material to migrant workers.

The women continue to serve as helpers in the Nursery during the Church hour. Each Sunday a beautiful flower arrangement is placed in the sanctuary by one of the women and in 1957 the flowers were given to the sick after the church service.
