The membership of the School of the Church declined from 427 at the beginning of the year to 403 at the end. This is believed to have been the result of sanitizing the class rolls rather than a loss of members. No new classes were added during the year.

The average weekly attendance during the period October-December, 1969, was 254. This represents an increase of 22 over the same period the previous year.

The organization established in September, 1968, continued in effect. This organization was recorded in the Superintendent of the School of the Church letter of September 19, 1968, and so reported to the Session. The practice of recruiting two teachers for each class has been continued. This practice has been successful in involving more adults in the teaching field and, hopefully, in training new teachers.

The School of the Church continued to use CLC material. It was supplemented in the Pre-School Division with material from David C. Cook Company.
