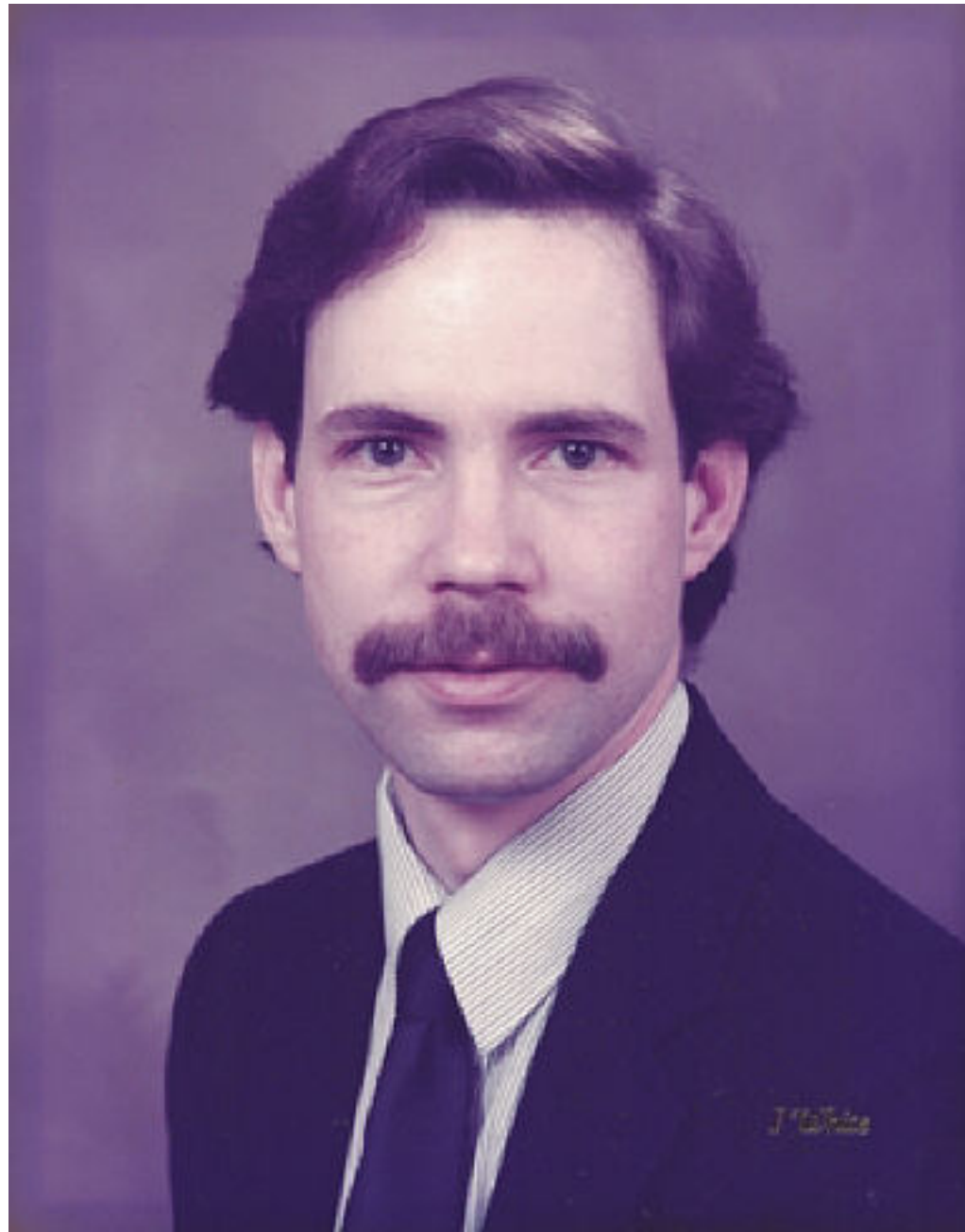


Former Associate Pastors of Our Church

Jamie was called to Bayside August 15, 1983. This was his first appointment as a pastor, and he was ordained and installed at Bayside Presbyterian Church by Dr. Rev. Keever.

He was married to Ginny, and they had a daughter Claire, and son Layton. The family resided at our (one-time) manse on Five Forks Road in Lake Smith Terrace.

Jamie was from Spartanburg, SC where his church home was First Presbyterian Church of Spartanburg. He was a graduate of Davidson College with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1980, and following that graduated in 1983 from Union Theological Seminary with a Masters of Divinity degree.

At Bayside he served in Christian Education, Nurture and Outreach of the Bayside congregation.

Jamie left Bayside on August 31, 1987 to work towards a Ph.D. in Old Testament

Studies at Duke University. He dropped us a note in 1991 to say he passed his preliminaries and was about to start on his dissertation. Ginny was expecting her book to be published soon, and was hoping to obtain a grant to study attitudes in different denominations and regions of the country towards violence against women. Jamie said he continued to keep up with events at Bayside through reading the Binnacle.
