In the very early days of the life of our Church, Mrs. William Graham, Jr., came to services in our small Chapel with its folding chairs, lone piano, two oil stoves, and a very small group of people. The enthusiasm and love of Christ of this group drew Mr. & Mrs. Graham into the fellowship of Robbins Corner Chapel, renamed Bayside Presbyterian Church October 25, 1953. She and her husband were Charter Members and have been active in many facets of the church life since those days of 1949.

Mrs. Graham taught in the Nursery for 3 years, was Superintendent of the Primary Department and a teacher for 8 years.

Mrs. Graham has served on the Building Committee, World Missions, Chairman of the Nominating Committee, Budget Committee, Church Extension, Circle Chairman, and Vice-President of the Women of the Church. She was **PRESIDENT OF THE WOMEN OF THE CHURCH DURING 1962-1963**. While serving as President, it was her honor to turn the first shovel of dirt at our new building site. She also served on our Pulpit Committee.

Mrs. Graham is now serving as Historian of the Women of the Church, Pastor's Aide, and serves on the Diaconate.
